All early voting sites are open the same days and hours,
from Wednesday, October 17 through November 3

Weekdays

7:00 am - 7:00 pm

Saturdays

8:00 am - 3:00 pm

Sundays

1:00 pm - 3:00 pm

SAME DAY VOTER REGISTRATION AT EARLY VOTING

If you have not registered to vote by 5:00 pm on October 12 when Voter Registration Books close, you can still vote in the November election by registering to vote at one of the Early Voting Sites. To do that:

You must bring a valid form of ID that shows your name and current address. It does not need to be a photo ID.

and

You must vote during Early Voting.

ABSENTEE VOTING

Requests for an Absentee Ballot may be submitted until 5:00 pm on October 30 using the required Absentee Ballot Request Form. Go to the Orange County Board of Elections website at www.orangecountync.gov/elect to find the form. You may submit it in person or by mail to **Orange County Board of Elections, 208 S Cameron St, Hillsborough, NC 27278**

Your completed Absentee Ballot must be returned to the Board of Elections by 5:00 pm on Tuesday, November 6.
